The LGBTI Virtual Visitors Scheme is a partnership between Nundah Activity Centre and the National LGBTI Health Alliance Silver Rainbow (LGBTI inclusive ageing and aged care).

The aim of the project is to reduce isolation and connect LGBTI elders with an LGBTI Virtual Community Visitor via Skype.

AM I ELIGIBLE?

Yes, if you are an elder that describes yourself as lesbian, gay, bisexual, trans/gender diverse or intersex. You can be living at home or in a residential aged care facility. You can be receiving home care services, other services or no services.

IS THERE ANY COST TO ME?

No, this is a free service.

DO I NEED A COMPUTER AND THE INTERNET?

No. We will:

- Provide an android tablet device to you if you don't already have one
- Set up the tablet device with a user-friendly screen.
- Arrange internet access.

LGBTI VIRTUAL VISITORS SCHEME

DO I NEED TO TRAVEL?

No, you are able to connect and chat with the LGBTI Virtual Community Visitor from your home.

HOW DOES IT WORK?

The LGBTI Virtual Community Visitor will arrange a convenient time, during the day or at night, to call you online. They will speak with you for an hour per fortnight or it can be broken into smaller sessions (e.g. 30 minutes per week). You will be able to see the Visitor on your screen and the Visitor will be able to see you on their computer using a video link.
